## **Jennifer Boysko Wins Nomination and Democrats Prepare for Special Election**

The Loudoun County Democratic Committee is pleased to announce that Jennifer B. Boysko has won the Democratic nomination for the Senate District 33 Special Election. Boysko won the election with 82% of the overall vote.

Boysko's opponents, Charlotte McConnell and Sharafat Hussain worked hard but ultimately fell short. The LCDC would like to thank both of them for helping drive turnout and excite the base of the Democratic Party in District 33.

The 33<sup>rd</sup> Senate District has become increasingly Democratic with Sen. Wexton being re-elected with 57% of the vote in 2015 and Governor Ralph Northam winning the District with 66% of the vote in 2017.

Democrats will now join together to prepare to defend the State Senate seat that Jennifer Wexton vacated when she became Congresswoman Elect for the 10<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.

"Voters want to know that their representative shares their values and will fight for them in the General Assembly. Jennifer Boysko has that record," commented Alfonso Nevarez, Chair Loudoun County Democratic Committee.

Jennifer has a long record as a tireless worker for Democrats, campaigning for virtually every Democratic candidate since 2003 in our region. During the 2017 cycle, Jennifer served as the House Democratic Caucus Finance Chair, raising hundreds of thousands to help elect the 15 new freshman members. Legislatively, she has worked to expand Medicaid, fought for common-sense gun reform, and has been on the forefront for non-partisan redistricting and reproductive freedom.

The Special Election will be held January 8, 2019.
